On June 30th 2022, Nathan Green was struck by a hit and run driver while cycling home from work. Nathan sustained a traumatic brain injury, as well as many broken bones. He is now undergoing treatment and recovering in the hospital.

Nathan is a really big part of the Louisville cycling community. He has managed Falls City Community Bicycle Works, Louisville's bicycle COOP for years helping to get people rolling with bicycles, as well as his full time job as a counselor for Louisville mental health organization Seven Counties.

He is the sole breadwinner for his wife and 4 year old daughter and this tragedy has put a financial burden upon his family. There is good news as Nathan is showing signs of progress and we are hopeful he will recover.


President Jeff White presents a check of support from the Louisville Bicycle Club to the Louisville Olmsted Parks Conservancy.

Did you notice any debris, glass, potholes, missing storm grates or other safety issue on your bike ride either on the road or in a bike lane? Did you report it?

One thing I do after a ride is open my Metro311 app and submit requests to the City. If you do not have the app, please download it. Submitting requests to Metro311 via the app is the most efficient way to report road hazards. The app allows you to move a pushpin on your screen to identify the precise location needing attention. You can also submit pictures. As a Metro Employee, I can tell you this: It it's not reported, it won't get fixed!



Lakeland High School (Lagrange, Indiana)



Amishland and Lakes, based at Lakeland High School in LaGrange, Indiana is a two day bike tour of the Amish countryside and lakes of northeast Indiana. Amishland and Lakes is all about enjoying riding, viewing the scenery, and socializing with other riders. We have participants from age 3 to 93, families, women's groups, and regional cycling clubs from throughout the Midwest, and we have been told that the ride is very "tandem friendly."

The Amishland and Lakes bicycle tour visits a world where lifestyles have remained almost unchanged for over a hundred years. The routes range from 22 to 100 miles, offering smooth, quiet roads, where buggies are numerous and cars are few. There are wide open spaces, clean country air, friendly people and lots of great food. There is plenty to explore, experience and eat. Amishland and Lakes is famous for great SAG food (watermelons, peaches, blueberries, bananas and fresh baked cookies), and there are Amish bakeries, restaurants and homemade ice cream parlors along the route for riders who want to sample local "home cooking".
